### Cabinet Forward Plan (Cabinet Meeting Date – 6 December 2017)

(b) to be significant in terms of its effects on communities living or working in an area comprising two or more electoral divisions in Dorset."

- 5. Information in respect of which a claim to legal professional privilege could be maintained in legal proceedings.
- 6. Information which reveals that the authority proposes:-
  - (a) to give under any enactment a notice under or by virtue of which requirements are imposed on a person; or
  - (b) to make an order or direction under any enactment.
- 7. Information relating to any action taken or to be taken in connection with the prevention, investigation or prosecution of crime.
