Aims

6 Options are being put forward to address HGV routing on the A350/C13 corridor between Blandford and Shaftesbury as part of wider route strategy.

- Option 1 One Way Advisory HGV Routing (Current) Northbound on A350 – Southbound on C13/B3081
- Option 2 One Way Advisory HGV Routing Northbound on C13/B3081 – Southbound on A350
- Option 3 One Way Enforceable HGV routing Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) Northbound on A350 – Southbound on C13/B3081
- Option 4 One Way Enforceable HGV routing Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) Northbound on C13/B3081 – Southbound on A350
- Option 5 C13 Melbury Abbas -Advisory 'Unsuitable for HGV' signs to discourage HGV drivers from the village
- Option 6 C13 Melbury Abbas 7.5
 Tonnes (except for Access) HGV Ban which would be enforceable to ensure HGV's do not travel through the village

These options will be considered by Cabinet to establish a clear way forward.

What is the background or context to the proposal?:

There have been community concerns for a number of years regarding traffic and specifically HGV's on the A350 and C13 between Blandford and Shaftesbury. Funding of £2.42m has been provided by the Department for Transport through it's National Productivity Investment Fund to tackle local community concerns.

There are potential negative impacts on school age children specifically in relation to Clayesmore School in Iwerne Minster if Options 5 or 6 are taken forward. Both of these options have the potential for increasing HGV movements along the A350. The school is a boarding and day school that sits on the west side of the A350 within the village, however, we have been informed that some boarders and the school art block are located on the east side of the A350 within the village thereby requiring pupils and staff to cross the A350. Officers from the Casualty Reduction have since met with the school to discuss current concerns and potential measures to address this issue.
