q Building resilience, supporting independence (BRSI)


q EiP is a way of working

q Shared understanding of how we work



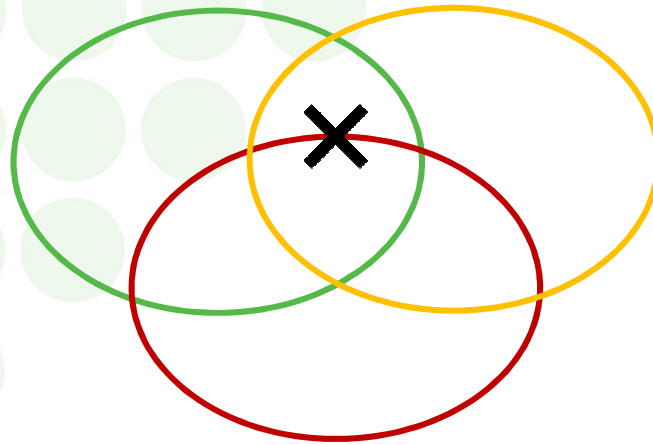
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- q Few dedicated resources
 - q The resources are already out there
 - q Salary costs teachers, youth workers, health visitors etc.
 - q Central functions and spend need to act like the control room for an emergency service (Why?)

- q Methods of identification
- q Penetration rates

- q Demand diversion
