Proposed fees and charges 2018/19

1. Purpose of report

To seek broad support for the proposed fees and charges, for inclusion in the draft 2018/19 budget.

2. Key issues

- 2.1 Policy Group has already considered the fees and charges for the Purbeck Sports Centre, tourism and planning pre-application advice. Following a suggestion from Policy Group, more benchmarking is being undertaken on the Sports Centre charges which will go back to Policy Group in January. This report provides the opportunity to consider all of the Council's other fees and charges. Policy Group is asked to give a broad indication of the appropriateness of the proposed fees and charges, which form the basis of the income estimates for 2018/19.
- 2.2 The income from the proposed discretionary fees and charges, together with estimated volumes, is anticipated to increase by 0.4%. Statutory fees and charges' income is anticipated to increase by 18.6%, which is largely due to an increase in the planning application fee budget of £60,000. The overall increase is 4.6% (£74,000). Whilst this compares favourably with the target of 2%, it is entirely due to an anticipated increase of 20% in statutory planning application fees.
- 2.3 The 2018/19 schedule of proposed discretionary fees and charges is attached as **Appendix 1**. Also attached, as **Appendix 2**, is a schedule of statutory charges for information. A summary of the budgetary effect of the proposed fees and charges is shown in **Appendix 3**, which also includes narrative around some of the budget movements. As the budget process continues officers will keep the income budgets under review and will update the estimates should further information on volumes become available. A schedule of fixed penalty notices is also attached at **Appendix 4**.

3. Recommendation

- 3.1 Policy Group gives broad support to the proposed fees and charges, as set out in Appendix 1, to be used as the basis for preparing the draft 2018/19 revenue budget, and the fixed penalty notices set out in Appendix 4.
- 3.2 Policy Group notes the statutory fees and charges, as set out in Appendix 2.
- 3.3 Policy Group supports implementation of the Government's proposed increase in planning fees when announced.

4. Policy issues

4.1 How will this affect the environment, social issues and the local economy?

No direct impact.

4.2 Implications

4.2.1 Resources

The income generated by the fees and charges presented forms the basis of the income estimates within the draft 2018/19 budget.

4.2.2 Equalities

Equality impact assessments will be completed on significant changes to fees and charges.

5. Further Information

- 5.1 Fees and charges should be set as part of the Council's approval of the revenue budget and council tax setting process in February. However, in order to provide Councillors with an opportunity to contribute to the budget setting process and to achieve a degree of certainty around aspects of the draft budget, Policy Group is asked to give a broad indication of the appropriateness of the proposed fees and charges which form the basis of the income estimates for the 2018/19 budget.
- 5.2 The Sports Centre charges, tourism website charges and planning pre-application advice have already been considered by Policy Group in October. All other discretionary fees are set out in Appendix 1. Statutory fees and charges are set out in Appendix 2 and the resulting budget implications for all fees and charges, including the Sports Centre, tourism and pre-application advice, are set out in Appendix 3. These are just the fees and charges budgets because cost centre information is not yet available in a complete form. Fixed penalty charges have also been scheduled and attached in Appendix 4 but the Council does not budget for an income from these charges. Whilst most of these are statutory the level of discount for prompt payment is discretionary.
- 5.3 In September, Council agreed the budget strategy target of increasing income generated by fees and charges by 2%.
- 5.4 The proposed discretionary and statutory fees and charges, including the Sports Centre and tourism website, together with estimated volumes, are anticipated to increase income by 4.6%. So the current proposals will exceed the strategy target but this is due to an increased budget for the statutory planning application fee income because of an anticipated increase in charges.
- 5.5 The table below shows how the increase in fees and charges is split over discretionary and statutory charges.

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- 5.6 The discretionary charges would have been up 1.6% without the budgeted 1.2% reduction in income of £14,950 for the Sports Centre, arriving at the net reduction of 0.4%.
- 5.7 Officers will keep the fees and charges budgets under review throughout the closing stages of the budget process and update them to reflect any revised estimates on volumes before the budget is approved in February.

Car parking (Appendix 1, item 22)

- 5.8 The last time Wareham and Corfe Castle East Street car park pay and display charges were increased was in 2014/15. Current year car park user numbers are only anticipated to be marginally up on last year. As a consequence, it is proposed that these charges are held for a further year.
- 5.9 Norden Car Park charges were last increased in 2016/17. Current year user numbers are anticipated to be slightly up on 2016/17, whilst 2016/17 user numbers were up 1,800 on 2015/16.
- 5.10 Norden is largely a tourist car park with a daily charge of £3.20. Many long stay tourist car parks command much higher parking charges and as a consequence often offer half-day charges as well. Norden, however, is also a transport interchange, aimed at relieving traffic from the road through Corfe Castle and on to Swanage. As a consequence, its daily charge has been pitched lower than it might otherwise have been.
- 5.11 Having regard to the above points two proposals were put forward for consideration for Norden, which were an increase of £0.30 in the daily charge to £3.50, or the introduction of a split charge of £3.20 for up to 4 hours and £4.50 for all-day. The second of these proposals carries risks, in that the significant increase in the all-day charge, whilst below many all-day tourist car park charges, may discourage visitors from using the car park and encouraging them to drive into either Corfe Castle or Swanage, increasing congestion on the roads. Also, whilst this proposal has the potential to significantly increase income it could also damage income if too many users opt for the below four hour charge, coupled with reduced user numbers.
- 5.12 Car park permit charges were also considered and a proposal was put forward to increase these by 5%.
- 5.13 The above proposals were included in the annual car parking fees and charges consultation exercise which takes place each year with interested parties. This year the consultation included: the District Councillors for Wareham and Corfe Castle, as these Councillors have car parks in their wards; the Economy and Infrastructure Portfolio Holder; clerks to both Wareham Town and Corfe Castle Parish councils; representatives at Swanage Railway, National Trust, the cycle hire company at Norden; and Wareham and Corfe Castle Chambers of Trade.
- 5.14 Those that responded to the consultation accepted the proposal to again hold the pay and display charges, with the exception of Norden, and for the increase in the car park permits. With regard to Norden Car Park, the preference was for no increase in the daily charge but, if that was not possible, then an increase in the daily charge to £3.50. There was no support for the split charge. Swanage Railway's response recognised the planned significant upgrades to the car park when supporting an increase in the daily charge to £3.50. It is therefore proposed to implement this charge.

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- 5.15 The budget implications of the above have been included in the attached appendices.
- 5.16 Following an interest in hiring Norden Car Park, it is proposed that a rental, based on a cost per square metre, be introduced (Appendix 1 item 22).

Cost recovery

- 5.17 The following discretionary charges (Appendix 1) have been increased to ensure cost recovery:
- Legal Services (section 2d & 2e), deed release and certificate of compliance
 - Health and Safety (section 10);
 - Animal Welfare (section 11);
 - Food Safety (sections 13b and 13c); and
 - Private water supply risk assessment (section 14h).

Statutory planning fees (Appendix 2 item 6)

- 5.18 The charges shown in Appendix 2, show the statutory increases required. The most significant movement is an increase in the planning application fee budget of £60,000, even though the charges are not increasing. This is because the Government is expected to agree a 20% increase in these charges from next year and the budget anticipates this. The regulations will require the increase to be spent on the planning service.

Fixed Penalty Charges (Appendix 4)

- 5.19 The budget assumes no income from fixed penalty charges, to avoid complaints that these charges have been issued to achieve budgetary targets.
