

Supplementary Information from the Objector

I also attach the tribunal write up, which is in the public domain, for an appeal regarding Cabman's Rest, the HMO mentioned in my objection.

In addition the .gov guide to case law aimed at Public Health authorities is attached as this includes case law, Thwaites which may be necessary for me to raise if the applicant legal advisor repeats his representation made at another hearing that evidence of harm is essential to refusing a license.

In addition I may rely on ex parte Christian Institute as mentioned in my objection.

Two files are attached which are google street views of the premises and what may be the route to safety from the fire exit at the rear. As can be seen it is gated, though in other pictures over the years the gate is shown open. If the committee members have any concerns in this regard they may wish to ask whether the gate is locked at night, whether there is any other route to safety than this and whether the applicant has a legal right to insist on this route being kept clear when the club is open if it is the only route to safety.

I have also mentioned the Public Sector Equality Duty, so if necessary intend citing s149 of the Equality Act 2010 to support that.
