#### 273. Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest made on this occasion.

## 274. <u>Community Governance Review – Final Recommendations</u>

The Chairman of the Community Governance Review Task and Finish Group submitted a report, a copy of which had been circulated to each Member and a copy of which appears as Appendix 'A' to these Minutes in the Minute Book. In presenting the report, the Chairman of the Task and Finish Group advised the Committee of the response from Ferndown Town Council regarding the boundary between West Moors and Ferndown parishes and asked the Committee to alter the proposed boundary to exclude the Police HQ site.

The Committee was asked to consider the proposals of the Task and Finish Group and to recommend to Council the final recommendations for the review of community governance for East Dorset.

The Committee debated the proposals for each area under review and in particular the boundary changes between Colehill and Wimborne.

Before being put to the vote, it was proposed and seconded that those Sections relating to Colehill and Wimborne Minster be deferred until a proposition can be put forward in the next session based on factual evidence and involving the two communities and their representatives.

Upon being put to the vote, the amendment was declared lost (3 votes for, 7 votes against).

#### **RECOMMENDED that:**

- (1) the following community governance and electoral arrangements for the parish of Alderholt be approved:-
  - (a) the parish of Alderholt should not be abolished;

- (b) no change be made to the boundary of the existing parish of Alderholt;
- (c) the name of the parish of Alderholt should not be altered;
- (d) the parish should continue to have a parish council;
- (e) the parish council for Alderholt consist of 9 councillors;
- (f) the existing wards of the parish of Alderholt be abolished; and
- (g) an East Dorset District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order be prepared in accordance with the above recommendations and that the Order be effective from 1 April 2015 save for those recommendations relating to parish council electoral arrangements which shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

  - (e) the name of the parishes of Chalbury, Horton, Wimborne St Giles and Woodlands should not be altered;
  - (f) the existing common grouping of parishes, Chalbury, Horton, Wimborne St Giles and Woodlands, to form Knowlton should not be altered:
  - (g) the grouped parishes referred to in (f) above should continue to have a parish council:
  - (h) the name of Knowlton Parish Council remain unchanged;
  - (i) the parish council for Knowlton consist of 10 councillors;
  - (j) the number of councillors elected to each of the respective parishes be as follows:
    - (i) Chalbury 1 councillor
    - (ii) Horton 3 councillors
    - (iii) Wimborne St Giles 3 councillors

- (iv) Woodlands 3 councillors
- (k) an East Dorset District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order be prepared in accordance with the above recommendations and that the Order be effective from 1st April 2015 save for those recommendations relating to parish electoral arrangements which shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015;

  - (e) an East Dorset District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order be prepared in accordance with the above recommendations and that the Order be effective from 1st April 2015.

- (c) the name of the parishes of Pamphill and Shapwick should not be altered;
- (d) no change be made to the existing parish grouping arrangements for the parishes of Pamphill and Shapwick;
- (e) the parish group should continue to have a parish council;
- (f) the parish council for Pamphill and Shapwick consist of 11 councillors;
- (g) the parish of Pamphill continue to be divided into two parish wards, comprising the area designated on the map [with official Reorganisation Order], and named respectively:
  - (i) Pamphill North
  - (ii) Pamphill South
- (h) the number of councillors elected to Pamphill North parish ward remain unchanged at 5 councillors;
- (i) the number of councillors elected to Pamphill South parish ward remain unchanged at 3 councillors;
- (j) the number of councillors elected to Shapwick parish be reduced from 5 to 3 councillors:

  - (b) no change be made to the boundary of the existing parish of St Leonards and St Ives;
  - (c) the name of the parish of St Leonards and St Ives should not be altered;
  - (d) the parish should continue to have a parish council;
  - (e) the parish council for St Leonards and St Ives consist of 13 councillors;
  - (f) the parish of St Leonards and St Ives continue to be divided into three parish wards, comprising the area designated on the map [with official Reorganisation Order], and named respectively:
    - (i) St Leonards and St Ives East
    - (ii) St Leonards and St Ives South
    - (iii) St Leonards and St Ives West

- (g) the number of councillors elected to St Leonards and St lves East parish ward remain unchanged at 6 councillors;
- (h) the number of councillors elected to St Leonards and St lves South parish ward remain unchanged at 3 councillors;
- (i) the number of councillors elected to St Leonards and St lves West parish ward remain unchanged at 4 councillors; and
- (j) an East Dorset District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order be prepared in accordance with the above recommendations and that the Order be effective from 1st April 2015 save for those recommendations relating to parish electoral arrangements which shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.
- (11) the following community governance and electoral arrangements for the parish of Sturminster Marshall be approved:-
  - (a) the parish of Sturminster Marshall should not be abolished;
  - (b) no change be made to the boundary of the existing parish of Sturminster Marshall;
  - (c) the name of the parish of Sturminster Marshall should not be altered:
  - (d) the parish should continue to have a parish council;
  - (e) the parish council for Sturminster Marshall consist of 9 councillors; and
  - (f) an East Dorset District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order be prepared in accordance with the above recommendations and that the Order be effective from 1st April 2015 save for those recommendations relating to parish electoral arrangements which shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

  - (d) the parish should continue to have a parish council in the style of a town;
  - (e) the parish council for Verwood consist of 18 councillors;

- (f) the existing parish wards of Stephens Castle and Newtown and Potterne be amalgamated;
- (g) the boundary of the existing parish ward of Dewlands South be altered to include the area transferred from Horton parish and referred to in (b) above;

- (k) the Local Government Boundary Commission for England be requested to make a related alteration order to alter the boundaries of the District Wards (Crane and Verwood West) and County Divisions (Cranborne Chase and Verwood & Three Legged Cross) to be coterminous with the parish realignment referred to in recommendation (b) above.

- (f) an East Dorset District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order be prepared in accordance with the above recommendations and that the Order be effective from 1st April 2015 save for those recommendations relating to parish electoral arrangements which shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015;
- (g) the Local Government Boundary Commission for England be requested to make a related alteration order to alter the boundaries of the District Wards (Ferndown Ameysford, Ferndown Central and West Moors & Holt) and County Divisions (Ferndown and West Moors & Holt) to be coterminous with the parish realignment referred to in recommendation (b) above.

- (d) the boundary of the existing parish of Ferndown be redrawn to the north, where it adjoins the parish of West Moors, so as to be conterminous with the alignment of the A31 from the Palmesford Roundabout to the boundary between the Police Headquarters Site and the Golf Course and then run in a northerly direction to join the existing boundary;

- (k) the number of councillors elected to each of the parish wards established in (i) above be as follows:
  - (i) Ameysford 3 councillors
  - (ii) Ferndown Central 3 councillors
  - (iii) Ferndown Central North 2 councillors
  - (iv) Ferndown Links 3 councillors
  - (v) Ferndown Links South 2 councillors
  - (vi) Hampreston and Longham 3 councillors
  - (vii) Stapehill 1 councillor
- (I) an East Dorset District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order be prepared in accordance with the above recommendations and that the Order be

- effective from 1st April 2015 save for those recommendations relating to parish electoral arrangements which shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015;
- (m) the Local Government Boundary Commission for England be requested to make a related alteration order to alter the boundary between the County Divisions (Ferndown and Colehill & Stapehill) so as to be coterminous with the District Ward boundary and remove the requirement for the anomalous parish ward comprising 240 electors;

  - (a) the parish of Wimborne Minster should not be abolished;
  - (b) the boundary to the existing parish of Wimborne Minster be redrawn to the east where it adjoins the parish of Colehill to:-
    - (i) transfer the properties currently in the parish wards of Colehill Lacey and Colehill Parmiter and those properties in Birchdale Road, Cranfield Avenue, Hornbeam Way, Onlsow Gardens, Pine Tree Close, Poplar Close, Rowlands Hill, Walford, Wesley Road and The Haven, Burts Hill to the parish of Wimborne Minster:
    - (ii) transfer the properties currently in the parish of Wimborne Minster in Highland Road, Highland View Close and Tower Lane to the parish of Colehill.
  - (c) the name of the parish of Wimborne Minster should not be altered:
  - (d) the parish should continue to have a parish council in the style of a town;
  - (e) the parish council for Wimborne Minster consist of 14 councillors;
