161. Taxi Driver Licence Application

The sub-committee considered a report to determine whether an application for a private hire drivers' licence should be given after a Police Caution was

revealed on the Disclosure and Barring Service Certificate during the application process.

The applicant was subsequently invited to put their case forward and all parties were given the opportunity to ask questions of each other and to sum up.

The sub-committee retired to make its decision.

Decision: To GRANT the application for a Private Hire Drivers' Licence subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. To undertake Safeguarding Training within the first 3 months of his licence; and
- 2. To register with HMRC within one month.
