3. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

A Temporary Event Notice has been served on the Council for a festival at Gaunts House, Wimborne for all ages which includes comedy, debate, talks and films, live and recorded music, kids area and large healing area for people who prefer alternative medical health choices and with a theme of personal choice and expression. The Notice has been considered by the Police and Environmental Protection. The Police and Environmental Protection have served Objection Notices. A Licensing Sub-Committee must consider the Notice and the Objection Notice at a public hearing.
