## **THE LICENSING ACT 2003 (HEARINGS) REGULATIONS 2005**

### Rights of a Party

1. A party has the right to attend the hearing and may be represented by any person.
2. A party is entitled to give further information where the authority has asked for clarification.
3. A party can question another party, and/or address the authority, with consent of the authority.

### Failure to Attend

4. If the authority is informed a party does not wish to attend, the hearing may proceed in their absence.
5. If a party has not indicated their attendance and fails to attend the hearing may be adjourned if considered in the public interest, or hold the hearing ensuring the party's representation is considered.
6. Where the authority adjourns the hearing it shall notify the parties of the date, time and place.

### Procedural Information

7. At the start of the hearing, the authority shall explain the procedure which it proposes to follow and shall consider any request for permission for another person to appear at the hearing.
8. A hearing shall take the form of a discussion led by the authority and cross-examination shall not be permitted unless the authority considers that it is required.
9. The authority will allow the parties an equal maximum period of time in which to speak.
10. The authority may require any person behaving disruptively to leave, and may refuse that person to return, but such a person may, before the end of the hearing, submit in writing information they would have been entitled to give orally had they not been required to leave.

### **FOOTNOTE:**

In relation to all other matters governed by the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005 any party or their representative may contact the Licensing Services at Dorset Council and they will be provided with a full copy of the regulations on request.

## **LICENSING SUB-COMMITTEE PROCEDURE**

1. At the start of the meeting the Chairman will introduce:
  - the members of the sub-committee
  - the council officers present
  - the parties and their representatives
2. The Chairman will then deal with any appropriate agenda items.
3. The Licensing Officer will be asked to outline the details of the application, including details of any withdrawn representations.
4. The applicant or their representative is then invited to present their case.
5. Committee members will be invited to ask questions.
6. Where appropriate the Responsible Bodies e.g. representatives of Police, Fire Services, Environmental Services or Trading Standards will be invited to address the sub-committee on any relevant representations they may have.
7. The Chairman may then allow an opportunity for questions.
8. The Chairman will ask any person who has made representations, who have already expressed a wish to do so, to address the sub-committee. The sub-committee will have read all the papers before them, including any letters of representation. Members of the public are asked to keep their comments concise and to the point.
9. All parties will be given the opportunity to “sum up” their case.
10. The Chairman will ask the Legal Advisor if all relevant points have been addressed before advising all parties present that the sub-committee will withdraw from the meeting to consider its decision in private. The sub-committee will be accompanied by the Democratic Services Officer and the Legal Advisor can be called upon to offer legal guidance.
11. The Chairman will:
  - advise when the sub-committee’s decision will be confirmed in writing.
  - Inform those present of their right to appeal to the Magistrates’ Court.

## **NOTE**

The Chairman may vary this procedure, as circumstances require but will have regard to the rules of natural justice and the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations 2005.

The meeting will take place in public. However, the public can be excluded from all or part of the meeting where the sub-committee considers that the public interest in so doing outweighs the public interest in the meeting or that part of the meeting, taking place in public.

Under no circumstances must the parties or their witnesses offer the sub-committee information in the absence of the other parties.

The Chairman and the Sub-Committee have discretion whether to allow new information or documents to be submitted and read at the meeting.

**Brief Summary:** An application has been made for a variation of the premises licence for William Henry, 1 Frederick Place, St Thomas Street, Weymouth. The application has been out to public consultation. Representations have been received. A Licensing Sub-Committee must therefore consider the application and representations at a public hearing.

**Recommendation:** The Sub-Committee determines the application in the light of written and oral evidence and resolves to take such steps as it considers appropriate and proportionate for the promotion of the licensing objectives:

- a) The prevention of crime and disorder
- b) The prevention of public nuisance
- c) Public safety
- d) The protection of children from harm

**Reason for Recommendation:** The Sub-Committee must consider all the written representations, the oral representations, and any information given at the hearing before reaching a decision.

## **1. Background**

1.1 Section 4 of the Licensing Act 2003 sets out the duties of the Licensing Authority, it sets out that a Council's licensing functions must be carried out with a view to promoting the four licensing objectives of:

- (a) the prevention of crime and disorder;
- (b) public safety;
- (c) the prevention of public nuisance; and
- (d) the protection of children from harm.

1.2 All applications and decisions are made with due regard to the [Licensing Act 2003](#) (the Act), the [Revised Guidance issued under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003](#) (the Guidance) and the [Dorset Council Statement of Licensing Policy](#) (the Policy).

## **2. Details of the application**

2.1 An application has been made for a variation of a premises licence for the William Henry, 1 Frederick Place, St Thomas Street, Weymouth and has been submitted to the Licensing Authority by JD Wetherspoon plc. The application form is attached at Appendix 1.

2.2 The description of variation given by the applicant is:

The application seeks to vary the Premises Licence as follows:-

Sale of Alcohol Thursday to Saturday 0900 to 0200

Late Night Refreshment Thursday to Saturday 0900 to 0200

Opening Thursday to Saturday 0700 to 0230

All Licensable Activities Thursday to Saturday 0900 to 0200 Sunday to Wednesday hours remain unchanged.

The application also seeks to vary the wording of condition (11) in Annex 2 of the Premises Licence to now read as follows:- (11) Persons under the age of 18 shall not be permitted to enter the premises after 23:00.

There are no further changes to the Premises Licence

2.4 To vary the wording of condition 11 in Appendix 2 of the premises licence from:

Persons under the age of 18 shall not be permitted to enter the premises after 2200 hours.

To be replaced with:

Persons under the age of 18 shall not be permitted to enter the premises after 2300 hours.

2.5 A copy of the current premises licence can be found at Appendix 2.

- 2.6 The Live Music Act 2012 allows any premises with a licence for the consumption of alcohol on the premises to have live amplified and recorded music between 08:00 and 23:00 without a licence. This only applies when the audience is under 500 people and takes place when the premises are open and being used for the sale of alcohol for consumption on the premises. The Legislative Reform (Entertainment Licensing) Order 2014 amended the Licensing Act and states that any conditions on a premises relating to any of this entertainment would not have any effect between 8am and 11pm or when the premises are open and selling alcohol for consumption on the premises.

### **3 Responsible Authorities**

- 3.1 Section 13 of the Licensing Act contains the list of Responsible Authorities who must be consulted on each application. Dorset Police, Dorset and Wiltshire Fire and Rescue Service, Dorset Council Public Health, Trading Standards, Children's Services, Planning, Licensing, Environmental Protection, Dorset Council Health and Safety and the Immigration Authority have all been consulted.
- 3.2 Environmental Health emailed the applicant to express their concerns in relation to the extension of regulated entertainment until 0200 hours owing to the flats above the premises and other residential properties in the vicinity. Following this email, the applicant discussed the issues raised with the Area Manager and it was agreed that the hours for regulated entertainment will remain as they are on the current premises licence. Environmental Health were satisfied with this decision and therefore, had no objection to the variation to the premises licence. A copy of these emails can be found at Appendix 3.
- 3.3 There were no representations received from any of the other Responsible Authorities.

### **4 Representations from other persons**

- 4.1 The Licensing Act 2003 Section 182 Guidance (the Guidance) sets out at 8.13 the role of "other persons":

"As well as responsible authorities, any other person can play a role in a number of licensing processes under the 2003 Act. This includes any individual, body or business entitled to make representations to licensing authorities in relation to applications for the grant, variation, minor variation or review of premises licences and club premises certificates, regardless of their geographic proximity to the premises. In addition, these persons may

themselves seek a review of a premises licence. Any representations made by these persons must be 'relevant', in that the representation relates to one or more of the licensing objectives. It must also not be considered by the licensing authority to be frivolous or vexatious. In the case of applications for reviews, there is an additional requirement that the grounds for the review should not be considered by the licensing authority to be repetitious. Chapter 9 of this guidance (paragraphs 9.4 to 9.10) provides more detail on the definition of relevant, frivolous and vexatious representations.

4.2 The Guidance states at paragraph 9.4 what a "relevant" representation is;

"A representation is "relevant" if it relates to the likely effect of the grant of the licence on the promotion of at least one of the licensing objectives. For example, a representation from a local businessperson about the commercial damage caused by competition from new licensed premises would not be relevant. On the other hand, a representation by a businessperson that nuisance caused by new premises would deter customers from entering the local area, and the steps proposed by the applicant to prevent that nuisance were inadequate, would be relevant. In other words, representations should relate to the impact of licensable activities carried on from premises on the objectives."

- 4.3 There were three relevant representations received, one from a member of the public, one from Dorset Councils Assets and Regeneration Team and one from Weymouth Town Council. The representations were made on the licensing objectives of Prevention of Crime and Disorder, and Prevention of Public Nuisance. Concerns were raised around noise from the premises and anti-social behaviour.
- 4.4 The representation from Weymouth Town Council was made on the grounds that the applicant wishes to play music outdoors until 0200 hours which may result in noise disturbance and public nuisance. However, following the emails between the Environmental Health and the applicant with the agreement that the hours for regulated entertainment would remain the same, Weymouth Town Council withdrew their representation.
- 4.5 The two remaining representations can be found at Appendix 4.
- 4.6 The Ward Member was in support of the application, subject to the inclusion of a condition requiring effective sound containment measures, namely double glazing, an automatically closing double-door entry system, and air conditioning to allow windows to remain closed during warmer months so that any sound from a DJ, recorded or live music is contained

and does not disturb neighbours. Following confirmation that the hours for regulated entertainment would remain unchanged, the Licensing Authority advised the Ward Member that such a condition was unnecessary.

## **5. Considerations**

5.1 The premises fall within the cumulative impact zone. The part of the policy relating to the cumulative impact policy is available under Background papers. Paragraphs 7.17 and 7.22 puts the onus on the applicant to demonstrate how the new premises will not add to the anti-social behaviour or crime and disorder, and the types of premises that are likely to be considered as such: “Applications for premises situated within a designated cumulative impact area for new premises licences or variations that are likely to add to the existing cumulative impact will normally be refused if relevant representations are received. It is for the applicant to demonstrate that their application would not add to the cumulative impact of such licensed premises in the area and so give good reason for the council to depart from its own policy. When considering an application where the subject premises is in a cumulative impact area, the council will need to be satisfied that the grant of the licence or variation will not impact on the cumulative impact of existing licensed premises in the area and as the burden of proof is on the applicant, they will often suggest measures which they assert will demonstrate there will be no impact. Examples of factors the licensing authority may consider as demonstrating there will be no impact may include, though are not limited to:

- Small premises who intend to operate up to midnight.
- Premises which are not alcohol led and only operate during the day time economy.
- Instances where the applicant is relocating their business to a new premises but retaining the same style of business.
- Conditions which ensure that the premises will operate in a particular manner such as a minimum number of covers or waiter/waitress service to secure a food led operation.
- Premises which will bring a variety of cultural activities to the area and expand the range of activities on offer for customers.”

## **6 Relevant Sections of the Licensing Act 2003**

6.1 Section 4 sets out the general duties of the Licensing Authority;

(1) A licensing authority must carry out its functions under this Act (“licensing functions”) with a view to promoting the licensing objectives.

(2) The licensing objectives are:

- (a) the prevention of crime and disorder;
- (b) public safety;
- (c) the prevention of public nuisance; and
- (d) the protection of children from harm.

(3) In carrying out its licensing functions, a licensing authority must also have regard to:

- (a) its licensing statement published under section 5, and
- (b) any guidance issued by the Secretary of State under section 182.

## **7 Relevant Sections of the Statutory Guidance issued under Section 182**

7.1 Paragraphs 1.2, 1.4 and 1.5 of the Revised Guidance issued under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003 issued in December 2023 (The Guidance) sets out the Licensing Objectives and aims;

The legislation provides a clear focus on the promotion of four statutory objectives which must be addressed when licensing functions are undertaken.

Each objective is of equal importance. There are no other statutory licensing objectives, so that the promotion of the four objectives is a paramount consideration at all times.

However, the legislation also supports a number of other key aims and purposes. These are vitally important and should be principal aims for everyone involved in licensing work. They include:

- protecting the public and local residents from crime, anti-social behaviour and noise nuisance caused by irresponsible licensed premises;
- giving the police and licensing authorities the powers they need to effectively manage and police the night-time economy and take action against those premises that are causing problems;
- recognising the important role which pubs and other licensed premises play in our local communities by minimising the regulatory burden on business, encouraging innovation and supporting responsible premises;
- providing a regulatory framework for alcohol which reflects the needs of local communities and empowers local authorities to

make and enforce decisions about the most appropriate licensing strategies for their local area; and

- encouraging greater community involvement in licensing decisions and giving local residents the opportunity to have their say regarding licensing decisions that may affect them.

7.2. Paragraph 1.16 of the Guidance sets out how conditions should be formulated;

Conditions on a premises licence or club premises certificate are important in setting the parameters within which premises can lawfully operate. The use of wording such as “must”, “shall” and “will” is encouraged. Licence conditions:

- must be appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives;
- must be precise and enforceable;
- must be unambiguous and clear in what they intend to achieve;
- should not duplicate other statutory requirements or other duties or responsibilities placed on the employer by other legislation;
- must be tailored to the individual type, location and characteristics of the premises and events concerned;
- should not be standardised and may be unlawful when it cannot be demonstrated that they are appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives in an individual case;
- should not replicate offences set out in the 2003 Act or other legislation;
- should be proportionate, justifiable and be capable of being met;
- cannot seek to manage the behaviour of customers once they are beyond the direct management of the licence holder and their staff, but may impact on the behaviour of customers in the immediate vicinity of the premises or as they enter or leave; and
- should be written in a prescriptive format.

7.3. Paragraph 1.19 states;

While licence conditions should not duplicate other statutory provisions, licensing authorities and licensees should be mindful of requirements and responsibilities placed on them by other legislation.

7.4 Paragraphs 9.42 – 9.44 of the Guidance set out how the Licensing Authority will determine an application;

Licensing authorities are best placed to determine what actions are appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives in their areas. All licensing determinations should be considered on a case by-case basis. They should take into account any representations or objections that have been received from responsible authorities or other persons, and representations made by the applicant or premises user as the case may be.

The authority's determination should be evidence-based, justified as being appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives and proportionate to what it is intended to achieve.

Determination of whether an action or step is appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives requires an assessment of what action or step would be suitable to achieve that end. While this does not therefore require a licensing authority to decide that no lesser step will achieve the aim, the authority should aim to consider the potential burden that the condition would impose on the premises licence holder (such as the financial burden due to restrictions on licensable activities) as well as the potential benefit in terms of the promotion of the licensing objectives. However, it is imperative that the authority ensures that the factors which form the basis of its determination are limited to consideration of the promotion of the objectives and nothing outside those parameters. As with the consideration of licence variations, the licensing authority should consider wider issues such as other conditions already in place to mitigate potential negative impact on the promotion of the licensing objectives and the track record of the business. Further advice on determining what is appropriate when imposing conditions on a licence or certificate is provided in Chapter 10. The licensing authority is expected to come to its determination based on an assessment of the evidence on both the risks and benefits either for or against making the determination."

## **8 Options**

- 8.1 The Sub-Committee will determine the application in the light of all of the written representations and any oral evidence from the hearing. They will take such steps as it considers appropriate and proportionate for the promotion of the licensing objectives of;
- a. The prevention of crime and disorder
  - b. The prevention of public nuisance

- c. Public safety
- d. The protection of children from harm

The steps that the Sub-Committee may take are:

- a. modify the conditions of the licence, or
- b. to reject the application

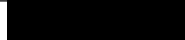

##### 1. Designated Premises Supervisor

No supply of alcohol may be made under this premises licence -

- at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or

2. Every supply of alcohol under this premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

3. The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

(2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises.

- (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
- b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
- d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
- e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability).
- 4. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
- 5. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
- (2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licences must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
- (3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either:-
  - (a) a holographic mark or
  - (b) an ultraviolet feature.
- 6. The responsible person shall ensure that -
  - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures -
    - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
    - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
    - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
  - (b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
  - (c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.

### Minimum Drinks Pricing

- 1. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
- 2. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 1 -
  - (a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979
  - (b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula -

$$P = D + (D \times V)$$

- Where -
  - (i) P is the permitted price
  - (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
  - (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
  - (c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence -
    - (i) The holder of the premises licence
    - (ii) The designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or

- (iii) The personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;
- (d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
- (e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.
- 3. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 would (apart from the paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
- 4. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 2 on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.
- (2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

#### If the Premises Licence allows Exhibition of Films

- 1. Where a premises licence authorises the exhibition of films, the licence must include a condition requiring the admission of children to the exhibition of any film to be restricted in accordance with this section.
- 2. Where the film classification body is specified in the licence, unless subsection (3)(b) applies, admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation by that body.
- 3. Where
  - (a) The film classification body is not specified in the licence, or
  - (b) The relevant licensing authority has notified the holder of the licence that this subsection applies to the film in question, admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation made by that licensing authority.
- 4. In this section "children" means any person aged under 18; and  
 "film classification body" means the person or persons designated as the authority under Section 4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984 (c39) (authority to determine suitability of video works for classification).

##### Prevention of Crime and Disorder

- (1) Any person exercising a security activity (as defined by paragraph 2(1)(a) of schedule 2 of the Private Security Industry Act 2001) shall be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) Such a person will be employed at the premises at the discretion of the designated premises supervisor/holder of the premises licence.
- (3) Any person as defined in condition (1) will clearly display his/her name badge at all times whilst on duty.
- (4) No customers carrying open bottles upon entry shall be admitted to the premises at any times the premises are open to the public.
- (5) Where CCTV is installed with recording facilities such recordings shall be retained for a period of 30 days and made available within a reasonable time upon request by the Police.

##### Public Safety

- (6) To comply with reasonable requirements of the fire officer from time to time.
- (7) To comply with the reasonable requirements of the building control officer.

##### Prevention of Public Nuisance

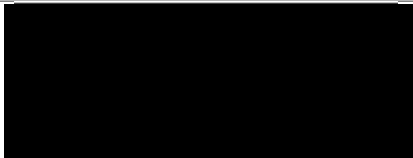

I work in Environmental Health at Dorset Council and we've been consulted on your application for a licence variation for the William Henry in Weymouth.

In addition to the extension to the proposed extension for alcohol sales and late-night refreshment, I saw the application also seeks to extend the timings for regulated entertainment until 2am and on Sunday 1am.

We had some concern about the extension of regulated entertainment until 2am owing to the flats above the pub and other residential in proximity and so I tried calling earlier today and then called and spoke to your manager at the William Henry. 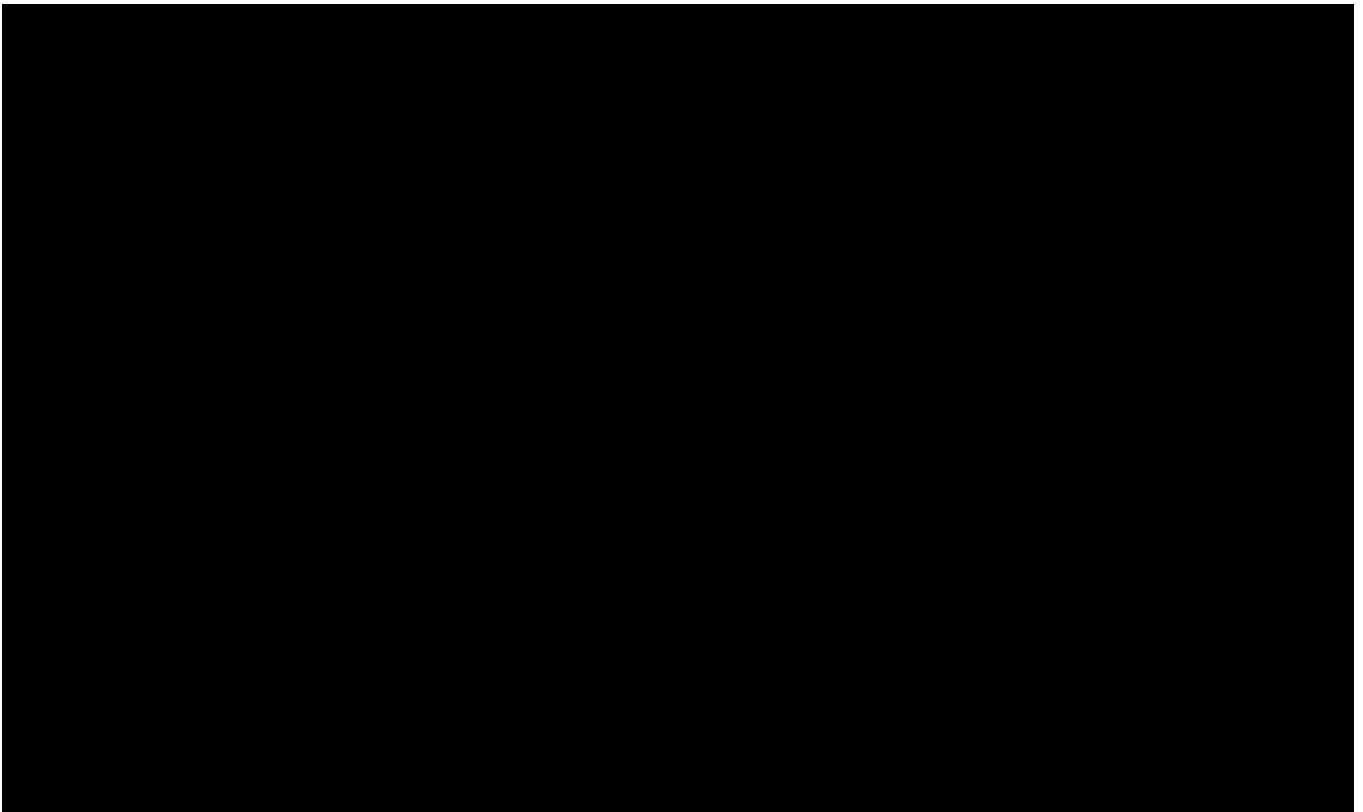

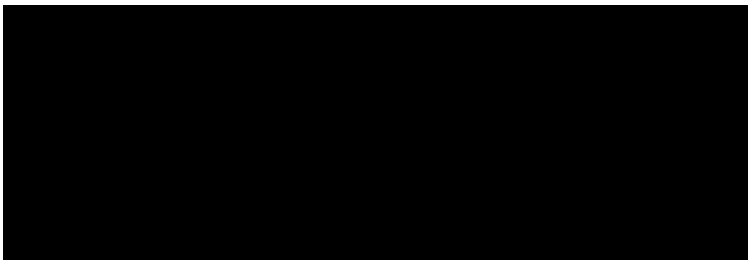

I have just been informed that William Henry, 1 Frederick Place, St Thomas Street, Weymouth, Dorset, DT4 8HQ has applied for a 2am license.

I have enclosed the below as I am still trying to find a way to log my comments on your website and before I am able to call you in working hours as it is now Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2026.

I lease a Boutique hotel  the William Henry on Westham Street. I have over 60% of my room inventory looking over the William Henrys troubled front doors, side entrance and main seating area.

We are a grade 2 listed building and in a conservation area as you will no doubt be aware of and have had to follow very, very strict laws from your planning office, enforcement agents and heritage to what we can and cannot do. None of which causes any more noise,

antisocial behaviour, fights, police disturbance and unacceptable behaviour. The William Henrys premises licence at the moment is unacceptable but to allow them to extend would completely destroy my Business.

You may think that this statement is rather dramatic. However, I have a 24-bedroom boutique hotel attracting guests who want some time away from busy lives, families, children etc. They want a lovely, safe, quiet environment to rest and relax. Their typical stay arrival have a rest, a few drinks locally, come back get ready and out for a nice dinner and arrive back generally before 12am for a good sleep finishing off their great stay in Weymouth.

To grant an extension to William Henry's hours will only attract people that are already in a party mode, potentially excessive alcohol, potentially antisocial behaviour to an area that already has this in an abundance. My business offering after working so hard to relax my guests is then ruined within hours by the William Henry who have been open since 7am and serving drinks from 9.00am.

As I have mentioned Chapter One is a grade 2 listed building in a conservation area and is governed by very strict laws on what can and cannot be changed. The windows of over 60% of my room stock overlook King William and the windows are unable to be changed as we are grade 2 listed. These windows are not double glazed and are old sash or metal windows which the glass panels are no more than 2mm thick.

To allow William Henry to extend their drinking hours would have a DETRIMENTAL impact on my business - through complaints, non-repeat business, reputation losing thousands and thousands on pounds for a 5-year-old business who is still making a name for itself in the Weymouth / Dorset market.

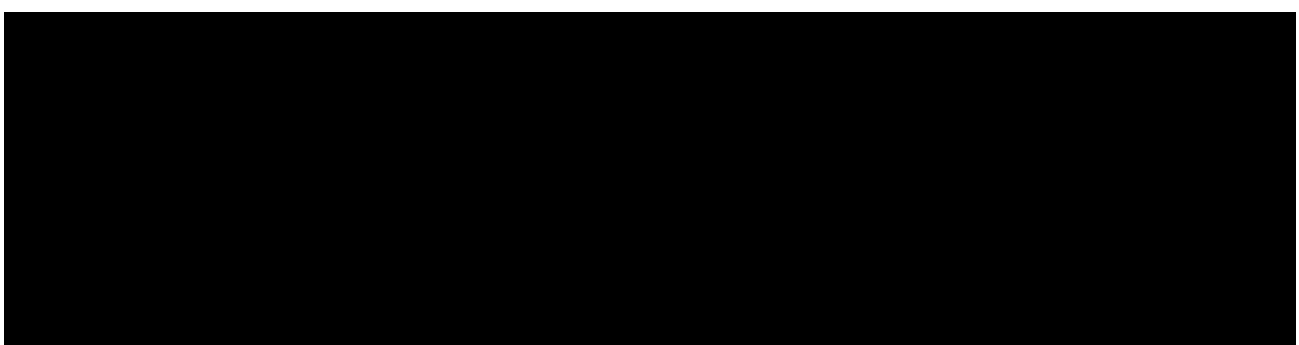

Chapter One is a Grade 2 listed building in a conservation area that rightly has protective conditions to the building and as a custodian my job is protecting it for future generations.

William Henry want to create another Weymouth hotspot attracting late night party goers and groups generating late night noise leading to antisocial behaviour, fights, unacceptable noise levels, police attendance with sirens. They are wanting to extend to 2.00am once they are closed at 2.00am this also brings on another dimension. The hanging about of antisocial, noise groups wanting more from shouting, arguing, fighting and then the local residence businesses such as me are forced to clear up William Henrys mess. In the past this has gone on until 4-5am.

As I have a responsibility so do you to protect all businesses and more importantly ensure our tourism industry is managed fairly in all areas. There are already too many places people can drink and party in Weymouth why create another one.

I run Chapter One as a boutique high end bed and breakfast only Hotel. I have 24 bedrooms which mainly overlook the William Henry on Westham Road. These rooms overlook their two main entrances, which are their only smoking areas and where their patrons are evicted for many reasons including, barred patrons, fights, drunken behaviour, unsocial behaviour etc. The unsocial behaviour, noise, fights happen outside the William Henry and not inside. Once they have been evicted the job of the staff is to keep them out fuelling more noise, unsociable behaviour and attracting more on goers. This is all without a 2am licence.

69% of my bedrooms which are my most popular overlook the William Henrys front two entrance and exit doors.

My property is not permitted to install double glazing as it is a grade two listed building and for that matter unable to do anything about noise reduction. The original panes of glass are old and no more than 2mm thick. My entrance is meters away from them.

As I said I am the only boutique high end hotel in Weymouth. I market and successfully attract guests that want to spend money in the various high-end restaurants we have in Weymouth, enjoy the more relaxed lifestyle and return to Chapter One for a good night's sleep in our exclusive Hypnos beds.

I have been awarded many accolades for hospitality whilst in Weymouth from The Times, The Guardian, The Sunday Times, Netflix's, William Sitwell to mention a few.

I have spent a lot of time and money renovating this grade 2 listed building whilst refurbishing it to an extremely high standard. Purchasing HRH approved bedding such as Hypnos mattress and linen for the best night's sleep in Weymouth.

I only cater for couples or singles as I do not accommodate, children, families, pets or groups.

The William Henry caterers as the majority of pubs do in Weymouth for the more parting individuals/Groups and the low cost of their alcohol entices people to take advantage of those from 9am every morning.

William Henry have ceased from having table and chairs outside their main entrance due to the problems that they were having from antisocial behaviour, abusive bar patrons etc

- The licence may stop at 2.00am but the partying patrons will hang around and the antisocial behaviour, fights, noise, groups of people, gatherings.
- The security that the William Henry employee or may employee have one job. Throw patrons out, prevent entrance to drunken, noisy, groups, antisocial behaviour patrons. Where do they then gather and tell everyone where they are outside my non-double-glazed bedrooms. Then the police are called and we get sirens and then more noise and unrest outside my hotel bedrooms.
- Why do they need to sell alcohol from 9am – 2.00am in the morning 7 days a week
- Giving the police another area to police after 12.00am.
- The core of my business is a safe, relaxed environment, guaranteeing a great undisturbed night's sleep and healthy breakfast.

As my last point indicates should you approve this extension - YOU will certainly be killing my business that I have worked so hard to bring to Weymouth by allowing another problem area in Weymouth.

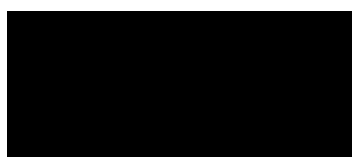

**Brief Summary:** An application has been made for a variation of the premises licence for the Slug and Lettuce, 56-57 St Thomas Street, Weymouth. The application has been out to public consultation. Representations have been received. A Licensing Sub-Committee must therefore consider the application and representations at a public hearing.

**Recommendation:** The Sub-Committee determines the application in the light of written and oral evidence and resolves to take such steps as it considers appropriate and proportionate for the promotion of the licensing objectives:

- a) The prevention of crime and disorder
- b) The prevention of public nuisance
- c) Public safety
- d) The protection of children from harm

**Reason for Recommendation:** The Sub-Committee must consider all the written representations, the oral representations, and any information given at the hearing before reaching a decision.

## **1. Background**

1.1 Section 4 of the Licensing Act 2003 sets out the duties of the Licensing Authority, it sets out that a Council's licensing functions must be carried out with a view to promoting the four licensing objectives of:

- (a) the prevention of crime and disorder;
- (b) public safety;
- (c) the prevention of public nuisance; and
- (d) the protection of children from harm.

1.2 All applications and decisions are made with due regard to the [Licensing Act 2003](#) (the Act), the [Revised Guidance issued under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003](#) (the Guidance) and the [Dorset Council Statement of Licensing Policy](#) (the Policy).

## **2. Details of the application**

2.1 An application has been made for a variation of a premises licence for the Slug and Lettuce, 56-57 St Thomas Street, Weymouth and has been submitted to the Licensing Authority by Amber Taverns Ltd. The application form is attached at Appendix 1.

2.2 The description of the proposed variation given by the applicant is:

To alter the structure of the premises in accordance with the plans submitted, namely:

To re-orientate the bar servery.

To change/alter some of the existing conditions in the operating schedule.

To reduce the terminal hour for the sale of alcohol.

To reduce the commencement hour on opening times.

- 2.4 To amend the condition under Appendix 2, Protection of Children From Harm, from:

“ A proof of age scheme such as Challenge 21 will be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are photographic identification cards such as a driving licence or passport.”

To be replaced with:

“Any person under the age of 25 wishing to purchase alcohol will be asked to produce ID before such a sale is made. Acceptable ID, picture driving licence, passport or PASS approve ID card and armed forces ID card”.

- 2.5 A copy of the current premises licence can be found at Appendix 2.
- 2.6 The Live Music Act 2012 allows any premises with a licence for the consumption of alcohol on the premises to have live amplified and recorded music between 08:00 and 23:00 without a licence. This only applies when the audience is under 500 people and takes place when the premises are open and being used for the sale of alcohol for consumption on the premises. The Legislative Reform (Entertainment Licensing) Order 2014 amended the Licensing Act and states that any conditions on a premises relating to any of this entertainment would not have any effect between 8am and 11pm or when the premises are open and selling alcohol for consumption on the premises.

### **3 Responsible Authorities**

- 3.1 Section 13 of the Licensing Act contains the list of Responsible Authorities who must be consulted on each application. Dorset Police, Dorset and

Wiltshire Fire and Rescue Service, Dorset Council Public Health, Trading Standards, Children's Services, Planning, Licensing, Environmental Protection, Dorset Council Health and Safety and the Immigration Authority have all been consulted.

- 3.2 There were no representations received from any of the Responsible Authorities.

#### **4 Representations from other persons**

- 4.1 The Licensing Act 2003 Section 182 Guidance (the Guidance) sets out at 8.13 the role of "other persons":

"As well as responsible authorities, any other person can play a role in a number of licensing processes under the 2003 Act. This includes any individual, body or business entitled to make representations to licensing authorities in relation to applications for the grant, variation, minor variation or review of premises licences and club premises certificates, regardless of their geographic proximity to the premises. In addition, these persons may themselves seek a review of a premises licence. Any representations made by these persons must be 'relevant', in that the representation relates to one or more of the licensing objectives. It must also not be considered by the licensing authority to be frivolous or vexatious. In the case of applications for reviews, there is an additional requirement that the grounds for the review should not be considered by the licensing authority to be repetitious. Chapter 9 of this guidance (paragraphs 9.4 to 9.10) provides more detail on the definition of relevant, frivolous and vexatious representations.

- 4.2 The Guidance states at paragraph 9.4 what a "relevant" representation is;

"A representation is "relevant" if it relates to the likely effect of the grant of the licence on the promotion of at least one of the licensing objectives. For example, a representation from a local businessperson about the commercial damage caused by competition from new licensed premises would not be relevant. On the other hand, a representation by a businessperson that nuisance caused by new premises would deter customers from entering the local area, and the steps proposed by the applicant to prevent that nuisance were inadequate, would be relevant. In other words, representations should relate to the impact of licensable activities carried on from premises on the objectives."

- 4.3 There was one relevant representation received from a member of the public. The representation was made on the licensing objective of the Prevention of Public Nuisance. Concerns were raised around noise from the premises.

## **5. Considerations**

- 5.1 The premises fall within the cumulative impact zone. The part of the policy relating to the cumulative impact policy is available under Background papers. Paragraphs 7.17 and 7.22 puts the onus on the applicant to demonstrate how the new premises will not add to the anti-social behaviour or crime and disorder, and the types of premises that are likely to be considered as such: “Applications for premises situated within a designated cumulative impact area for new premises licences or variations that are likely to add to the existing cumulative impact will normally be refused if relevant representations are received. It is for the applicant to demonstrate that their application would not add to the cumulative impact of such licensed premises in the area and so give good reason for the council to depart from its own policy. When considering an application where the subject premises is in a cumulative impact area, the council will need to be satisfied that the grant of the licence or variation will not impact on the cumulative impact of existing licensed premises in the area and as the burden of proof is on the applicant, they will often suggest measures which they assert will demonstrate there will be no impact. Examples of factors the licensing authority may consider as demonstrating there will be no impact may include, though are not limited to:

- Small premises who intend to operate up to midnight.
- Premises which are not alcohol led and only operate during the day time economy.
- Instances where the applicant is relocating their business to a new premises but retaining the same style of business.
- Conditions which ensure that the premises will operate in a particular manner such as a minimum number of covers or waiter/waitress service to secure a food led operation.
- Premises which will bring a variety of cultural activities to the area and expand the range of activities on offer for customers.”

## **6 Relevant Sections of the Licensing Act 2003**

- 6.1 Section 4 sets out the general duties of the Licensing Authority;

(1) A licensing authority must carry out its functions under this Act (“licensing functions”) with a view to promoting the licensing objectives.

(2) The licensing objectives are:

- (a) the prevention of crime and disorder;
- (b) public safety;
- (c) the prevention of public nuisance; and
- (d) the protection of children from harm.

(3) In carrying out its licensing functions, a licensing authority must also have regard to:

- (a) its licensing statement published under section 5, and
- (b) any guidance issued by the Secretary of State under section 182.

## **7 Relevant Sections of the Statutory Guidance issued under Section 182**

7.1 Paragraphs 1.2, 1.4 and 1.5 of the Revised Guidance issued under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003 issued in December 2023 (The Guidance) sets out the Licensing Objectives and aims;

The legislation provides a clear focus on the promotion of four statutory objectives which must be addressed when licensing functions are undertaken.

Each objective is of equal importance. There are no other statutory licensing objectives, so that the promotion of the four objectives is a paramount consideration at all times.

However, the legislation also supports a number of other key aims and purposes. These are vitally important and should be principal aims for everyone involved in licensing work. They include:

- protecting the public and local residents from crime, anti-social behaviour and noise nuisance caused by irresponsible licensed premises;
- giving the police and licensing authorities the powers they need to effectively manage and police the night-time economy and take action against those premises that are causing problems;
- recognising the important role which pubs and other licensed premises play in our local communities by minimising the regulatory burden on business, encouraging innovation and supporting responsible premises;

- providing a regulatory framework for alcohol which reflects the needs of local communities and empowers local authorities to make and enforce decisions about the most appropriate licensing strategies for their local area; and
- encouraging greater community involvement in licensing decisions and giving local residents the opportunity to have their say regarding licensing decisions that may affect them.

7.2. Paragraph 1.16 of the Guidance sets out how conditions should be formulated;

Conditions on a premises licence or club premises certificate are important in setting the parameters within which premises can lawfully operate. The use of wording such as “must”, “shall” and “will” is encouraged. Licence conditions:

- must be appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives;
- must be precise and enforceable;
- must be unambiguous and clear in what they intend to achieve;
- should not duplicate other statutory requirements or other duties or responsibilities placed on the employer by other legislation;
- must be tailored to the individual type, location and characteristics of the premises and events concerned;
- should not be standardised and may be unlawful when it cannot be demonstrated that they are appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives in an individual case;
- should not replicate offences set out in the 2003 Act or other legislation;
- should be proportionate, justifiable and be capable of being met;
- cannot seek to manage the behaviour of customers once they are beyond the direct management of the licence holder and their staff, but may impact on the behaviour of customers in the immediate vicinity of the premises or as they enter or leave; and
- should be written in a prescriptive format.

7.3. Paragraph 1.19 states;

While licence conditions should not duplicate other statutory provisions, licensing authorities and licensees should be mindful of

requirements and responsibilities placed on them by other legislation.

7.4 Paragraphs 9.42 – 9.44 of the Guidance set out how the Licensing Authority will determine an application;

Licensing authorities are best placed to determine what actions are appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives in their areas. All licensing determinations should be considered on a case by-case basis. They should take into account any representations or objections that have been received from responsible authorities or other persons, and representations made by the applicant or premises user as the case may be.

The authority's determination should be evidence-based, justified as being appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives and proportionate to what it is intended to achieve.

Determination of whether an action or step is appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives requires an assessment of what action or step would be suitable to achieve that end. While this does not therefore require a licensing authority to decide that no lesser step will achieve the aim, the authority should aim to consider the potential burden that the condition would impose on the premises licence holder (such as the financial burden due to restrictions on licensable activities) as well as the potential benefit in terms of the promotion of the licensing objectives. However, it is imperative that the authority ensures that the factors which form the basis of its determination are limited to consideration of the promotion of the objectives and nothing outside those parameters. As with the consideration of licence variations, the licensing authority should consider wider issues such as other conditions already in place to mitigate potential negative impact on the promotion of the licensing objectives and the track record of the business. Further advice on determining what is appropriate when imposing conditions on a licence or certificate is provided in Chapter 10. The licensing authority is expected to come to its determination based on an assessment of the evidence on both the risks and benefits either for or against making the determination."

## **8 Options**

8.1 The Sub-Committee will determine the application in the light of all of the written representations and any oral evidence from the hearing. They will take such steps as it considers appropriate and proportionate for the promotion of the licensing objectives of;

- a. The prevention of crime and disorder
- b. The prevention of public nuisance
- c. Public safety
- d. The protection of children from harm

The steps that the Sub-Committee may take are:

- a. modify the conditions of the licence, or
- b. to reject the application

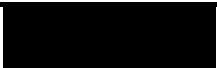

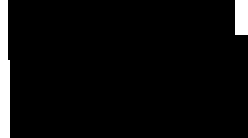

## Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions

### SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL (s19(2)&(3))

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence –
  - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor, or
  - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence has been suspended

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence

### SECURITY (s21(A))

2. Any individual carrying out a security activity must be authorised to carry out that activity by a licence granted under the Private Security Industry Act 2001 or be entitled to carry out that activity by virtue of section 4 of that Act.

## EXHIBITION OF FILMS (s20(2))

3. Admission of children must be restricted in accordance with any recommendation by the British Board of Film Classification or the Licensing Authority.

## DRINKS PROMOTIONS

- 4
  - (1) The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises
  - (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises—
    - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—
      - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
      - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
    - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
    - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
    - (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;
    - (e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability).
5. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
6.
  - (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
  - (2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.
  - (3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either—
    - (a) a holographic mark, or
    - (b) an ultraviolet feature.
7. The responsible person must ensure that—
  - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures —
    - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
    - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
    - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml;
  - (b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
  - (c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.”

## MINIMUM PRICING

8. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
9. For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 6—
  - (a) “duty” is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979
  - (b) “permitted price” is the price found by applying the formula -  $P=D+(D \times V)$ 
    - (i) P is the permitted price,
    - (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
    - (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
  - (c) “relevant person” means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence—
    - (i) the holder of the premises licence,
    - (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
    - (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;
  - (d) “relevant person” means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
  - (e) “value added tax” means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.
10. Where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 7 would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub- paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
11. (1) Sub-paragraph (2) applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph (b) of paragraph 7 on a day (“the first day”) would be different from the permitted price on the next day (“the second day”) as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.  
  
(2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.

## Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

### Prevention of crime and disorder

A CCTV system shall be installed at the premises and maintained in good working order and used at all times when the premises are open for licensable activities.

Any CCTV footage shall be held for 31 days and shall be made available to an officer of the Licensing Authority or Police on reasonable request.

Where Pubwatch exists covering the area of which the premises is situated then the DPS or other nominated employee shall participate in Pubwatch.

The need for door supervisors will be assessed by way of risk assessment and cognisance will be taken of any Police advice.

The premises shall maintain a written drugs policy, which shall be made available to the Police or an authorised officer of the Council upon request.

An incident log book (which may be electronic) shall be kept on the premises and made available on request to an authorised officer of the Council or Police which will record the following:-

- a) Any incidents of disorder
- b) Any seizures of drugs or offensive weapons
- c) Any ejections of patrons

The premises shall maintain a written dispersal policy, which shall be made available to the Police or an authorised officer of the Council upon request.

## Public safety

The Premises licence holder understands their obligations under existing legislation and takes their responsibility seriously.

## The prevention of public nuisance

Reasonable steps will be taken to recognise the rights of local residents and notices will be displayed at the premises exits requesting customers to leave quietly and reminding them that they are in a residential area.

The premises shall maintain a noise limiter at the premises and all amplified music shall be subject to the control of the noise limiter.

Doors and windows of the premises shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment in the form of live or DJ led music is being played, save for access and egress.

## Protection of children from harm

A proof of age scheme such as Challenge 21 will be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are photographic identification cards such as a driving licence or passport.

A log (which may be electronic) shall be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. The log shall include the date and time of the refusal and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. A copy of the log or electronic report shall be made available upon reasonable request.

All bar staff to receive appropriate training in relation to alcohol sales prior to commencing their duties. This will include the premises licence conditions, underage sales policy and other relevant licensing matters. Training documents (which may be in an electronic format) shall be made available to an authorised police officer and licensing authority officer upon request.
