## 1. Summary of the Complaint

The Complainant alleged unacceptable behaviour by Cllr P Yeo in a meeting of Shaftesbury Town Council on 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2020 in breach of the Code of Conduct and which could be reasonably regarded as bringing his office or the Council into disrepute. The specific complaint is that Cllr P Yeo mouthed an offensive word with equivalent hand gesture in front of the camera and despite a request by the Chairman to retract or apologise for his actions, made no attempt to do so.

## 2. The Conduct of the Hearing

The conduct of the hearing is as detailed in the Audit and Governance (Hearing) Sub-Committee minutes, a copy of which are appended to (and forms part of) this Decision Notice. A recording of the hearing is available click here

## 3. The Hearing Sub-Committee's Decisions

- 3.1 The Hearing Sub-Committee's decisions are detailed in the appended minutes. However, the Hearing Sub-Committee's key conclusions are also set out below.
- 3.2 Members of the Sub-committee having viewed the agenda documents and the videos and having listened very carefully to all of the representations made found that the standards displayed by Cllr P Yeo in a public meeting to be vulgar, rude and offensive and therefore found most strongly that Cllr P Yeo breached the Shaftesbury Town Council Code of Conduct, specifically Section 2.1(b) 'respect to others' and Section 2.2(g) 'bringing the council into disrepute'
- 3.3 It was agreed that the Sub-committee send the clearest message that this type of conduct will not be tolerated and therefore censure Cllr P Yeo in the strongest possible terms.
