Under this license application there is the potential for 5000 attendees at any one time over three/four days, this taking place in the midst of a village of just over 100 inhabitants.

There is potential for an unprecedented amount of traffic on unclassified single track roads. The designated parking [in a farmer's field] is for one day only with no overnight parking. ***For the other days there is no designated parking.*** There is little safe parking in the village for residents let alone for an event of this scale.

The noise is especially disturbing when attendees are vacating the site particularly around midnight. Volume of traffic, security, parking issues and the amount of heavy vehicle traffic involved in setting up the event.

This event has totally out grown the village of Langton Herring which is not a suitable venue for such a large scale event that has a detrimental impact on local residents.
