Subject: Chesil Rocks application for a new premises license Langton Herring

Having read Mr Warren's application for a premises license I have major concerns. Although it is stated that this years' event will be three consecutive days from Thursday 15th to Saturday 17th June, this application is for four days in June from 1200 to 2300hrs including Sunday giving the ability of considerable future expansion without needing permission. No mention is made of limiting numbers on site at any one time in the application. We are a small village and Mr Warren has stated he could have up to 1000 people on the previous temporary event notice without needing permission. I note that this license allows up to 5000 people without notification. The narrow lanes of our very small village simply could not cope with such a huge influx of people and I request that a limit be made on numbers attending. Parking is also not addressed. We have narrow lanes in the village with no parking. The road into the village is also not suitable for parking. Emergency services need access at all times. A local farmer offers parking on a steeply sloping field on the Saturday for the main event but has stated that it is not available at any other time. Traffic management is not covered in the application but needs addressing for the reasons above. The license has no time limit as no end date has been stated on the form I suggest the following conditions are imposed upon this licence in the interests of public safety

- 1 Limit of three consecutive days in June from Thursday to Saturday. Sunday is not a suitable day for an event like this which finishes so late at night.
- 2 A definite limit to be placed on numbers attending each day as our small village cannot accommodate large numbers
- 3 Parking must be provided on Thursday and Friday as the field will not be available on these days
- 4 A time limit for this application should be imposed ? four years
- 5 Supervised traffic management advised by the highways department should apply to each day.
