I would like to back the application for an alcohol licence from mr Tim Warren of Higher Farm Langton Herring. He and his wife Hilary have been organising annually, a charity event, CHESIL Rocks, a very successful music and arts festival in the grounds of their home at Langton Herring for about ten years now. The Saturday is very much a popular family day out with a wide variety of music throughout the day and entertainment provided for the children.

It has always been an extremely well organised event with plenty of security people about and I-have never seen any trouble: to the contrary, it has always been a very friendly event with almost the whole village and surrounding area supporting either as volunteers or as guests at the events.

The popular bar has each year made a good profit which helps towards the running costs, and all the profits from the festival have always very generously been donated to the Samaritans of Dorset at Weymouth.

We are an independent branch who have to raise all our own funding. We receive no government grants and it costs between £40-45,000 a year keep the branch running.

Over the last few years the proceeds of CHESIL Rocks have covered at least half our costs so it is a very important sponsor of our local branch.
