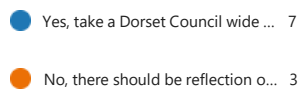

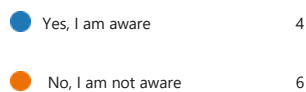
1. Have you heard of the regulatory regime for contaminated land, under Part 2A of the Environmental Protection Act 1990?



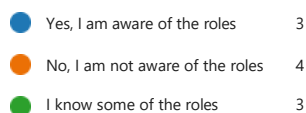
