Due to space constraints and local noise considerations, no acoustic drum kits, backing tracks with heavy bass, or subwoofers will be permitted."

Please supply the general steps that would apply to all four licensing objectives	Staff training ensuring all employees are thoroughly trained on their responsibilities, emergency procedures and age verification policies, CCTV systems or security staff will be installed and used via the appropriate SIA, incidents logs will be used at the venue to record any incidents of refusal of sales and security incidents. RISK assessments will be regularly updated that identify potential hazards across all four objectives such as the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance and the prevention of children from harm.
The steps you will be taking to promote the prevention of crime and disorder	cctv installation able to record images of entries, exits and till Areas, licensed door supervisors through SIA for crowd management if needed, responsible retailing not offering irresponsible drinks promotions

The steps you will be taking to promote the prevention of public nuisance	Noise management, most of our live music events will be during daytime hours or end before 21:00 hours unless for a private party or event. We will inform our local residents with a letter stating all times and dates on which we will be and when available live music will be taking place. We will display prominent notices asking patrons to leave quietly and have active door staff encourage customers to depart without disturbing local residents. The venue will operate under a strict Noise Management Plan to promote the licensing objectives and prevent disturbance to nearby residents: 1. Thursday Evening Controls: All live music will cease strictly at 21:00 and will remain entirely unamplified to preserve evening tranquility for neighbouring properties. 2. Saturday and Sunday Afternoon Controls: Amplified music is strictly restricted to a short two-hour daytime window (between the hours of 12:30 - 20.30). Apart from Wimborne folk festival being an exception.. All portable amplifiers and PA speakers will be positioned facing inward, away from the nearest noise-sensitive residential boundaries, using the natural layout of the courtyard walls to baffle the sound. 3. Bass and Percussion Limits: No acoustic drum kits or subwoofers are permitted. Any bass guitar used will be restricted to a low-wattage practice amplifier raised completely off the ground to prevent structural vibrations from travelling through courtyard paving. 4. Active Management and Volume Control: The venue manager retains absolute control over the master volume of all equipment and will reduce levels immediately if required. 5. Proactive Monitoring: The on-site manager will carry out a physical boundary noise check 15 minutes after the start of both Thursday Saturday and Sunday sessions to ensure sound levels do not dominate ambient street noise. A written log of these checks will be maintained on-site and made available to Dorset Council officers upon request."
The steps you will be taking to promote public safety	We will ensure our capacity limits are not breached and an occupancy level will be omitted. All fire exits will be labelled appropriately and functioning fire safety equipment will be maintained with a clearly marked assembly point for evacuation. Adequate first aid supplies will be on site as well as a designated first aider. any cautions will be clearly labelled also and log books will be kept to report any incidents , an operational checklist will be put in place for all staff to utilise upon their shifts and signatures will assigned to make sure it has been read and acknowledged .

The steps you will be taking to promote the protection Of children from harm	Age verification will be in place such as the Challenge 25 proof of age scheme to prevent underage drinking, Access restrictions will be in place to prohibit unaccompanied minors entering the premises at certain hours, or exclude all under 18s when adult entertainment is taking place. If under 18s are employed we will ensure the sale of alcohol isn't enforced unless they are serving diners at their tables. Or accompanied by the appropriate trained over 18 member of staff. All incidents will be logged in the appropriate accompanied log books.
